All applicants must be at least 5 years old by August 31, 2010 (except those applying for Cumberland Road Pre-K).

CHOICE SCHOOL APPLICATION DIRECTIONS

All assignments will be for a full academic year. Students can change assignments during the school year only if they move out of their current attendance area or meet hardship requirements.

Any student whose choice is to remain at their assigned home district school will **not** need to complete an application. Students requesting to remain at their current choice school will be provided with a "choice intent" form to be completed by the parent and returned to the Student Assignment Office. The completed "intent" form must be received at the Student Assignment Office no later than January 12, 2010 in order for the student to remain at their current choice school.

1. Transportation will not be provided outside of the assigned home school attendance area. (Exception: Busing will be provided for students living in the Lewis Chapel district that are accepted to attend Anne Chesnutt). Parents must provide timely transportation to and from school each day if no exception for transportation has been made. (*Failure to provide timely transportation may result in student transfer to their home school*)
2. Siblings who also make application will be assigned to the same school if older sibling is selected.
3. Selection will be based on space available. Students will be assigned their choice to the fullest extent possible. If your choice is not available, the student will be assigned to their home school. All Cumberland County students will have an opportunity to participate in choice schools based on availability, facilities, and consideration of special needs.

DEADLINE: Choice applications for students presently residing in Cumberland County will be accepted by mail January 5, 2010 through **February 16, 2010**. Applications for students not residing in Cumberland County as of February 1, 2010 will be accepted by mail until **June 1, 2010**. (Student must reside in Cumberland County with parent or court appointed custodian before the first day of school to be eligible to attend Cumberland County Schools.) **If for any reason your child is accepted into a high school academy after the deadline has passed, he/she cannot participate in interscholastic athletics for 365 days from the date of acceptance.**
