Drop-Off / Pick-up Location:

The agricultural classrooms are located near the back of the school building near the baseball field. As you enter off of Chickenfoot Road, please take the first entrance to the school and follow the road around the right side of the building. Drop off will be at a classroom with an external door across from the greenhouses. Look for the decorations and sign! Please escort your children into the classroom and be sure you have been greeted by either a teacher or student counselor before leaving.

Students will remain inside the classroom at pick-up until a parent comes in to get them. This is to ensure the safety of the child. Please note that ID is required for pickup.

Proper Attire:

As part of this mini-camp we will be outside periodically. Please dress your child for clothing that is appropriate for the weather and comfortable. We suggest close-toed shoes and socks. They will also be “playing in the dirt” as part of some activities so clothing that can get a little dirty would be ideal. If they would like to bring a hat to wear if outside they are welcome to do so.

Sunscreen:

Depending on the weather, children may be exposed to sun. Please consider this when preparing for the day with clothing choices and sunscreen.

Food and Drinks:

Campers will be provided with plenty of water to drink to stay hydrated. Each camper will also have the opportunity to eat a snack mid-morning if they would like. These snacks will be based around the daily theme and may include things such as peanut butter and jelly sandwiches, cheese, pudding, crackers, and smores. If your child has any special dietary restrictions PLEASE make these clear on the first day and if necessary, send your own snack that is suitable from home.

Field Trips

As part of this week we will be taking our campers on two field trips in our community. As the details of these trips are confirmed, we will be sending out additional permission forms and information to those who are registered by email. Transportation will be via school activity bus while on these trips.

Daily Reminders:

If needed, we will send home a paper reminder of any special needs for the following day.

Awards “Graduation” Ceremony:

On Friday at 10:30am, we will be having our graduation ceremony and pizza party. This will take place in the school cafeteria. Parents and other family members are welcome to attend to celebrate with these children what they have learned over the week and will be presented with a certificate. Campers will share songs and skits that were learned over the course of the camp and see a photo slideshow of the week events. Parents are asked to RSVP by Thursday with a number of adults to expect so we may order enough pizza for everyone.
