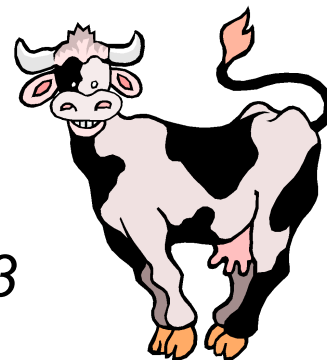


# Gray's Creek High School's Agricultural Education Program

# “ADVENTURES IN AGRICULTURE”

## Daily Adventure Schedule Overview

*\*Daily Topics are Subject to Change\**

### **Monday: Plants Alive (Horticulture)**

Campers will get to explore our school greenhouse and gardens to learn about how to grow and care for plants including fruits, vegetables, and ornamental flowers. Activities will include visiting our vegetable garden and learning about the importance of bees to flowers and how we get honey. Children will leave at the end of the day with a flower pot they created themselves to remember the lessons of the day.

### **Tuesday: Tractors & Plows & Corn Oh My! (Agronomy & Agricultural Equipment)**

Participants will spend the morning investigating machines that help grow our food through a field trip to a local farm! We will take a look at how equipment such as tractors, combines, and planters help produce row crops such as corn, soybeans, wheat, and cotton. Campers will get to see just how much of an impact these crops make in our daily lives!

### **Wednesday: Barnyard Friends (Livestock and Small Animals)**

Today is all about animals on the farm and our furry little friends such as cats and dogs. Campers will focus on the use and care of animals along with a visit from veterinarian technician to show us how they help sick animals. We will also see a demonstration of grooming and caring for our livestock in our school barn which includes rabbits, goats, and chickens. Children will help create their own snack using milk products!

### **Thursday: Get Hooked! (Environmental & Natural Resources)**

Campers will get to go on a field trip (location to be determined) where they will get a chance to explore topics such as camping, fishing, wildlife conservation, and fire safety to prevent wildfires.

### **Friday: Harvest Celebration and Graduation**

This last morning will consist of time spent reviewing the week and what all they have learned. We will celebrate through a pizza party where campers will be able to identify how things we learned during the week helped to make their meal! Campers will get to wear their t-shirts and be recognized for completing the week during a graduation celebration where parents and family are welcome to attend.
