

Dress Code for Students 2021-2022

Cumberland County Schools Expectations for All Students

- a) No undergarments should be visible at any time.
- b) Clothing should not cause a disruption to the educational environment.
- c) Students may not wear or carry clothing, jewelry, book bags, or other personal articles that depict or display profanity, vulgarity, obscenity, nudity of any degree, violence, alcoholic beverages, tobacco, controlled substances, firearms, or any illegal activity, or which advertise products or services illegal to minors.
- d) Any symbols, styles or attire frequently associated with gangs, intimidation or violence which are disruptive to the educational environment are prohibited.
- e) Adornments or accessories, such as chains or spikes, that could reasonably be perceived to be a weapon or could be utilized as a weapon are prohibited.
- f) Head coverings (including hats, hoods, sweat bands, and bandanas) are generally prohibited in school buildings. However, students may wear head coverings in the school building as an expression of sincerely held religious belief (e.g., hijabs or yarmulkes) or cultural expression (e.g., geles) or to reasonably accommodate medical or disability-related issues (e.g., protective helmets).

Additional Expectations for SFCMS Students

- No skin more than three (3) inches above the knee may be visible, all the way around the leg, either by length, holes, slits, transparent material or any other insert.
- Sagging pants are not allowed.
- Leggings, yoga pants, or any other skin tight clothing will be considered undergarments and must be worn with appropriate dress attire which comes to no more than 3 inches above the knee.
- Shirts revealing a student's stomach, midriff, back, or sides are not permitted.
- No clothing that shows cleavage is permitted.
- No sheer or see-through fabric in tops or bottoms is allowed unless it has solid fabric underneath it; this includes but is not limited to, crochet, lace, sheer, or knitted fabrics.
- Bedroom attire is not allowed.
- No sunglasses will be worn in any fashion.
- **Shoes must be worn at all times, cover both the toe and heel, and have a hard sole. No Crocs are allowed.**

- Coats/jackets may not be worn inside the classroom unless approved by administration.
- Students are permitted to use bags, but these must be stored in a locker throughout the school day.
- Water bottles must be plastic or another soft material.

Physical Education

- ***T-shirt*** - Clean t-shirt. Tank tops and half shirts will not be permitted.
- ***Shorts*** - Clean pair of athletic shorts that will stay in place without being held by hand or belt.
- ***Pants*** - Sweatpants or jogging suits may be worn during cold weather at the teacher's discretion.
- ***Socks*** - Clean athletic socks.
- ***Shoes*** - Rubber-soled tennis shoes.

Gym bags may be used only to transport gym clothes. Gym bags may be carried either before or after the period the student has PE, but should be placed in the locker at the student's earliest opportunity.
