### Eligibility Requirements

- Must be a CCS high school senior
- Gain admittance to a college or university with a NC accredited Educator Preparation Program for the Fall 2021 semester
- Intend to pursue a K-12 teaching career with Cumberland County Schools in one of the following licensure areas:
  - Birth to Kindergarten
  - Career and Technical Education, CTE
  - Elementary Education
  - English/Language Arts
  - English Second Language
  - Math
  - Science
  - Social Studies
  - Special Education
  - World Language

### Application Requirements

- **Application Cover Sheet**  
Enter the requested information.
- **One-Page Résumé**  
Complete the résumé template detailing your desire to teach, your school, community, and volunteer activities, leadership positions held, and any honors or awards received. You may also include any hobbies, special interests, and/or jobs held in this section. Résumés are strictly limited to one typed page.
- **Future Educators Reference Forms**  
Two electronic reference forms are required. One reference form must be completed by a teacher. The second form must be completed by another adult who can speak to your academic accomplishments, community involvement, and potential to be a successful educator. **Email this link to the two people who will serve as your references:**
