How long do I have to submit immunization and health assessment documentation?	In accordance with state law, the parent/guardian enrolling a student for the first time into a North Carolina school must present proof of immunization and a current NC Health Assessment Transmittal Form within 30-days of the first day of school attendance. Failure to submit documentation on the approved form within 30 calendar days of the first day of attendance will result in dismissal.
