

16 Annual Bulldog Classic S.O.P.s

1. General:

A. The 16th Annual Bulldog Invitational Drill Competition is a drill meet sponsored by Terry Sanford High School AFJROTC. This drill meet will be held on **NOV 23, 2019**.

B. The drill competition will begin at 0830 with a Commander's meeting in the Media Center of Terry Sanford High School. The competition will begin at 0900. There will be a lunch break from 1215 to 1300.

C. Terry Sanford High School, AFJROTC, the United States Air Force, Cumberland County Schools, and NC-032 will not be held responsible for the loss of personal items during the competition on our campus. Each unit is responsible for securing their own property.

D. Terry Sanford High School, the United States Air Force, Cumberland County Schools, and NC-032 will not be held liable for personal injury at any time before, during, or after the drill competition.

2. Judging:

A. Each participating team will provide 2 - 3rd or 4th year cadets that are knowledgeable on all aspects of drill. They will become part of our Inspector General (IG) Judging team for this event. TSHS IG Team will be lead by our Drill Team CC and ASI; he or she will oversee Judging team members. Each IG team member will be assigned a drill event to judge. IG team members will not judge their home team during any event except during knockout. IG team members may not compete in any home team drill events, even when not utilized as an IG Judge.

3. Administration:

A. Location: Terry Sanford High School is located at 2301 Fort Bragg Road, Fayetteville, NC.

B. Meals: Full meals will be available for purchase at Terry Sanford High School. Pizza, drinks and assorted snacks will be sold in the school cafeteria. Pre order \$5 meal is two slices of pizza, chips, cookies and soda.

C. Fees: There will be a **\$50 entry fee plus \$15 per event entered**. Make checks payable to **Terry Sanford High School AFJROTC**. Teams withdrawing after COB . **9 NOV. 2019** will forfeit their fees.

D. A matrix will be mailed as soon as all team entries have been finalized. Only one team per event will be allowed.

E. **In case of inclement weather**, the competition will be held in our gyms. Demilitarized weapons will be required to have butt pads in the gyms.

4. Rules:

A. All cadets participating must be AFJROTC cadets enrolled in their respective programs.

B. Uniforms: Any military uniform with headgear will be authorized for the competition. **Regulation events must be in regulation blue uniforms including Color Guard. Utility uniforms may be used in exhibition but must be standardized.**

C. Weapons: There will be no restrictions on the type of demilitarized weapons used.

D. Saluting: The drill area will be a **NO** salute area.

E. Team Composition:

Flight: minimum of 13 cadets and a maximum of 21 cadets, including the flight commander and flight sergeant.

Element: minimum of 6 cadets and a maximum of 10 cadets, including the Commander.

Color Guard: Four cadets, minimum

AS-100 Element: For this drill meet, AS-100 is defined as a cadet who is either currently enrolled in AFJROTC-100 or **HAS COMPLETED AFJROTC-100 BUT HAS NOT YET SAT IN THE SEAT FOR AFJROTC-200 CLASS (ie; scheduled for spring class).**

F. Drill Areas:

Armed and Unarmed Flight: 75ft X 100 ft.

Armed and Unarmed Element: 60ft X 90 ft.

Color Guard: 50ft X 90ft

Individual: 30ft X 50ft

AS-100 Element: 45ft X 90ft

Dual: 40ft X 75ft

G. Time Restrictions:

Fancy Flight/Element Drill

Fancy Individual Drill

3-5 min All Events

Fancy Dual Armed

5. Awards:

A. Will be presented in the school auditorium after the completion of knockout drill. Trophies will be awarded for first, second, and third place overall and first, second, and third place for each event. Trophies will be awarded for the first two places in knockout. Trophies will be awarded based on total points.

6. Description of Events:

A. **Regulation Drill:** These events will be judged in accordance with AFMAN 36-2203, FM 21.5, and the AFJROTC Drill and Ceremonies Text. All commands for the event must be given from memory. All movements will be executed in the order presented on the score sheet. The score sheet lists only the movements to be performed, not necessarily the correct command.

B. Teams may drill early if the matrix indicates open times or scheduled teams are not in the ready area.

C. Units who cancel an event, please mark the score sheet and give it to judge of that event. That way, all units are accounted for.

D. **Exhibition Drill:** This competition is not a dance type drill. The commander may move his/her unit on the drill area in any manner; however, the movements executed by the drill teams must maintain military bearing. The uniform worn will up to the individual unit, but keep in mind that the unit will

be graded on general appearance, including neatness and military image. The judging and timing will begin as soon as the first command is given or as soon as the team breaks the boundary line, whichever comes first. The time will end when the last person exits the drill pad. There will be a reduction of points if the routine does not remain within the given time for the event. (1 point per second above or below the time limits)

E. The AS-1 event is to give cadets experience in performing at a drill meet. Trophies will be given, but will not count toward scoring for overall.

F. There will be Armed and Unarmed Knockout Competition (Unarmed Knock out will also have a AS100 only event) after all the scheduled events are completed. **Tickets will be available in the cafeteria and boosters for \$1.00 for each event.**

7. Logistics:

A. Storage of weapons in the responsibility of team or unit. Terry Sanford High School or NC-032 will not provide arms storage.

B. Restrooms: Restrooms and changing areas located down the hall and to the left after entering the main school entrance on both levels, and at other locations shown on the school diagram and labeled.

C. Lodging: Participating schools are responsible for providing their own lodging, however, the following are recommended if needed:

8. Penalties: Penalties will be assessed as follows:

A. Less than minimum required composition: 10 points (per 3E above)

B. Crossing a boundary line: 10 points

C. Failure to adhere to specified time limits: 1 point per second over or under time limitations.

D. Color Guard: Teams will be scored a “O” if either flag touches the ground at any time during the sequence.

E. Unauthorized contact with judges, poor sportsmanship, or inappropriate behavior: 25 points.

F. In armed events: 10 point deduction per each **COMPLETE** drop. No deduction if weapon is caught when only one end touches the ground.

G: **To insure the safety of our and YOUR CADETS there will be NO standing on rifles, or people; there will be no use of rifles to form towers of any kind.**

H: Any violations of safety will result in disqualification for that event.
