## ***HLA Appearance Guide***

- WHITE, NAVY or BLACK Shirts with collar (***logos or color of any kind are not allowed***)
- WHITE, NAVY or BLACK crewneck sweatshirts may be worn with a collar shirt underneath sweatshirt
- All undergarments must be solid and neutral colored. (***under shirt sleeve, must not be longer than outer shirt sleeve***)
- BLACK, NAVY or TAN pants, skirts, jumpers or shorts. (***Cargo, Capri, or Short Shorts not allowed***)
- Skirts, shorts or jumper lengths must extend below the fingertips when arms are straight down along the sides (***stretch or tight fitting material are not allowed***).
- Belts (***black, tan or brown***) must without decorative buckles may be worn with clothing with belt loops (chain belts, spikes, sashes)
- WHITE/ BLACK base Tennis Shoes. (***Shoes must be tied at all times***).
- May wear one pair of small stud earrings and a watch.
- Smart watches , ***rings or necklaces or body piercing are not allowed***).
- Pants must be worn at full length (***roll ups or oversized clothing is not allowed***).
- Pants must be worn at the waist (***sagging or exposed undergarments are not allowed***).
- Hats or head covering are not permissible
- Clothing must be slogan and logo free of all writing. (***Absolutely no offensive language or symbols***).
- Gang emblems, signs, symbols, clothing, bandanas or colors are prohibited.
- Tattoos must be covered at all times.
- Personal hygiene is a must – ***students should be clean, neat and well-groomed at all times***.
- Students may not wear extra clothing under their uniform This is to include no shorts, legging and thermal pants under uniform pants.
- Brushes, combs or picks are not allowed.
- Students are not allowed to have anything over \$3 on their person; anything over will be confiscated and returned to the parent in a sealed envelope.

We are requesting that you submit a copy of your child's updated immunization record and/or a completed NC Health Assessment signed by your child's primary health care provider to school staff.

Dear HLA Family Members,

In our continuing efforts to support the well-being of all our students, we are administering a universal screener of social, emotional & behavioral health. Our district is using the Behavior Intervention Monitoring Assessment System-2 (BIMAS-2) research-based screening tool. The focus of this universal screener is to increase support systems for CCS students. To determine which support systems will be beneficial to our CCS students, your child will be invited to participate in a brief survey that consists of 34 questions and takes 3-5 minutes to administer.

Your child will complete the BIMAS-2 questionnaire electronically about their actions and emotions during a one-week time span. Examples of some of the questions include:

- During the past week I shared my thoughts with others.
- During the past week I had trouble paying attention.
- During the past week I followed directions.
- During the past week I was sad or withdrawn.

For each question, the student will answer “never,” “rarely,” “sometimes,” “often,” or “very often.”

Once completed, the BIMAS-2 results will be reviewed by the teacher and Student Services staff at the school. The aim is to help students be successful and the BIMAS-2 results will allow for the development of interventions and strategies (i.e., small groups, individual contracts, use of calm corners, etc.) to promote student success.
