2022-2023 Student Intent to Ride the School Bus Survey - Deadline Next Week

Free Summer Meals for Children (18 Years and Younger) to End This Week

Cumberland County Schools' Child Nutrition Services provides free meals to children during the summer through the Summer Meals Program, which will end on July 28th. There are no income requirements or registration. Meals must be consumed at the site location. Anyone age 18 or younger may receive a free meal. Lunch will be available 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. on Monday, July 25 - Thursday, July 28, on a first-come, first-served basis at the specific locations. Free and Reduced Lunch Application is Open Now

Federal waivers that allowed universal free lunches are ending. Starting immediately, parents and guardians are urged to submit meal applications online by visiting www.LunchApplication.com. While all students can still receive breakfast at no cost, students at non-[Community Eligibility Provision](#) schools must pay for meals or qualify for free lunch for the upcoming school year. The [Free & Reduced Meal Application](#) must be submitted each year and can be done online to reduce paperwork at the beginning of the school year.
